

Good evening and welcome to tonight's concert, and an especially warm welcome to the musicians and audience members from Thurstable school. Tonight's concert marks the start of the band's 40th year and we're very grateful to the school for enabling us to celebrate that milestone with an event that continues the band's founding mission of encouraging young musicians. Today's workshop and concert wouldn't have been possible without all of Mrs Thomson's help and hard work, so a huge thanks to her, and thanks also to the church for welcoming us back so warmly and (hopefully) fitting us all in.

As a number of you are no doubt attending your first concert with us...a history of the band may be of interest. According to the village archives, there have been brass or military bands in West Bergholt for over a hundred years, but the current band was formed relatively recently back in November of 1978, helped by the discovery of some old brass instruments under the stage in the village hall. That discovery was made by a music teacher (Sid Cooper) from West Bergholt who wanted to set up a band where the young musicians he taught across Essex could mix with some less young musicians to perform all types of music in an enjoyable atmosphere. The band's first rehearsal included a mere 6 players, but as Sid was a hugely popular teacher, the band quickly became full of school-age musicians with some adults helping them along.

These days the band's membership is more evenly split between currently young and previously young, but we still hold true to Sid's original vision, and it's that which I believe has kept the band successful for all these years. The band is proud to include musicians of all ages and to perform all styles of music (a programme that includes Holst and Lady Gaga is about as diverse as you can get!) - and I know we'll enjoy performing tonight's concert as much as we've enjoyed our afternoon rehearsal with the school.

If you've read this far...you can see how maintaining a band membership of all ages is key to the band's continued success, and has the added benefit of keeping the types of music the band plays fresh. Sid is sadly no longer with us to encourage his pupils into the band (that's how I joined exactly 35 years ago), so schools events such as today are how we maintain a flow of young musicians into the band.
