It's the audience involvement that makes our concerts here such fun, so as always we're looking forward to you joining in with us whenever & however you like - sing along, hum along, clap along, or rattle your jewellery (as John Lennon would say). Those in the band that are playing here for the first time are in for a treat (& even a shock) when they see how much you join in and how much fun we have together.
