A warm welcome to this afternoon's concert & thanks very much for coming along. We always look forward to our concerts here and I know we'll have an enjoyable afternoon together. As always we encourage you to join in whenever you like - sing along, hum along, clap along, wave your flags or programmes - especially for the proms pieces. Those in the band that are playing here for the first time are in for a treat (& a surprise) when they see how much you join in and how much fun we have together.

The band have been playing at the West Cliff for as long as I can remember, starting in the 1980s under the baton of our founder Sid Cooper through to the early 1990's with my brother Jeff conducting, including the memorial concert we held here for Sid in 1990. Whilst the band was rebuilding in the mid-1990s after the loss of Sid, the West Cliff was always the venue we missed the most, so I was delighted to be able to bring the band back here in March 2000. Since then we've played here at least once every year (except for lockdowns) so this is a theatre and audience which hold a special place in the band's hearts & history.

This afternoon's concert is a result of an audience request to play a "Last Night Of The Proms Concert" when we were here last March. I can't believe it's 11 years since we last played a proms concert here, so it was a great idea. I also can't believe 2024 marks 30 years since I took over conducting the band full time, so alongside the proms pieces we'll be playing some pieces I remember from my days as a young Clarinet player in the band back in the 1980s. Sid was my inspiration to be a musician and conductor, so to be conducting the band in the same spot as he did, and to be conducting some of the pieces he conducted is the best possible way I could honour his inspiration and celebrate 30 years of waving my arms about and pointing a white stick.

We are always grateful that so many of you come to our concerts - the band have been blessed with wonderfully supportive & interactive audiences whenever we play here, so thanks again for coming along, and we hope you enjoy the concert.
